Facts About NSD

What?

- Established as part of the Research Council of Norway in 1971
- Set up in 2003 as a limited liability company 100% owned by the Norwegian Ministry of Education and Research
- Main funding from
 - Research Council of Norway
 - Ministries
 - EL
 - Universities and colleges

Why?

 Facilitate empirical research that primarily depends on access to relevant and high quality data

How?

- Ensure easy access to data and services for the research community
- To provide guidance for researchers and students in the fields of data collection, data analysis, data methodology, protection of privacy and research ethics

 Remove financial, technical, knowledge-based, legal and administrative barriers between users





NSD's Objectives

1971

- To improve opportunities and framework conditions for empirical research






